After some years as a performing musician Owain Clarke began to teach music in a secure children's home, where he was increasingly impressed by the power of music as an agent for change and healing. This led him to study music therapy at the University of the West of England, qualifying in 2001.

He joined Hampshire MusicSpace, which later became Key Changes, and since then has worked in multiple settings across Hampshire and the Isle of Wight.
